Officer placed him under arrest, upon searching him, a four-inch switchblade knife was found on his person, a crack pipe and keys. RIHM Super Abdul notified/responded, said male was a former terminated employee, had no authority to be on premises. Other officers arrived at scene. Perp. was "Mirandized" en-route to 114 <sup>th</sup> Pct.
